



**Boil Water Advisory**  
**To Customers of Breezy Hill Water & Sewer Co., Inc.**  
**Effective August 01, 2024**

The General Manager advises the customers of Breezy Hill Water & Sewer Co., Inc. residing in the following area, that experienced an interruption in their water service due to an unexpected main break on August 01, 2024, 2024 to vigorously boil their water for at least one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking, until further notice.

Addresses included are:

The intersection of Birch Street and Cherokee Drive to the intersection of Willow Lane and Corley Rd to include Roads Hillcrest Drive, and 300-400 block of Gilmore Ave.

There has been no confirmed contamination of the system. However, because of the interruption in service, the potential for contamination exists. Therefore, as a precautionary measure, the customers of the water system that have experienced an interruption in service are advised to vigorously boil their water for at least one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking once service is restored, until notified otherwise. Also, any ice made from water which has not been boiled should not be used for drinking purposes.

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) is presently working with the water system to handle the problem.
