



Boil Water Advisory
To Customers of Breezy Hill Water & Sewer Co., Inc.
Effective February 3, 2026

The General Manager advises the customers of Breezy Hill Water & Sewer Co., Inc. residing in the following areas that experienced an interruption in their water service due to an unexpected main break on February 3, 2026, to vigorously boil their water for at least one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking, until further notice.

Addresses included are in Graniteville, SC
Baker St., Brantley St., Randolph's Corner Ln., Polatty St., Arbute St., Holsenbeck St.,
Eubanks Loop, Hester Ln., 200-500 Main St., & 20 Chalk Bed Rd.

There has been no confirmed contamination of the system. However, because of the interruption in service, the potential for contamination exists. Therefore, as a precautionary measure, the customers of the water system that have experienced an interruption in service are advised to vigorously boil their water for at least one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking once service is restored, until notified otherwise. Also, any ice made from water which has not been boiled should not be used for drinking purposes.

Once the water service has been restored and lines have been flushed, our laboratory will collect and analyze bacteriological samples. Once these results are received, approximately 24 hours from collection time, we will advise if the boil water advisory can be repealed.

The South Carolina Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) is presently working with the water system.
